BETTYS
An iconic family business founded in Harrogate on 17th July 1871 by a young Swiss confectioner, Fritz Bützer, who changed his name to Frederick Belmont.
The first Bettys Café Tea Rooms opened near this site at 9 Cambridge Crescent.
In 1962 Bettys purchased C E Taylor & Co, tea and coffee merchant and opened Bettys flagship branch in this building, in what was previously Taylors Café Imperial.
Our Swizo-Yorkshire heritage lives as strongly as ever; though, to this day, the identity of 'Betty' remains a mystery.
