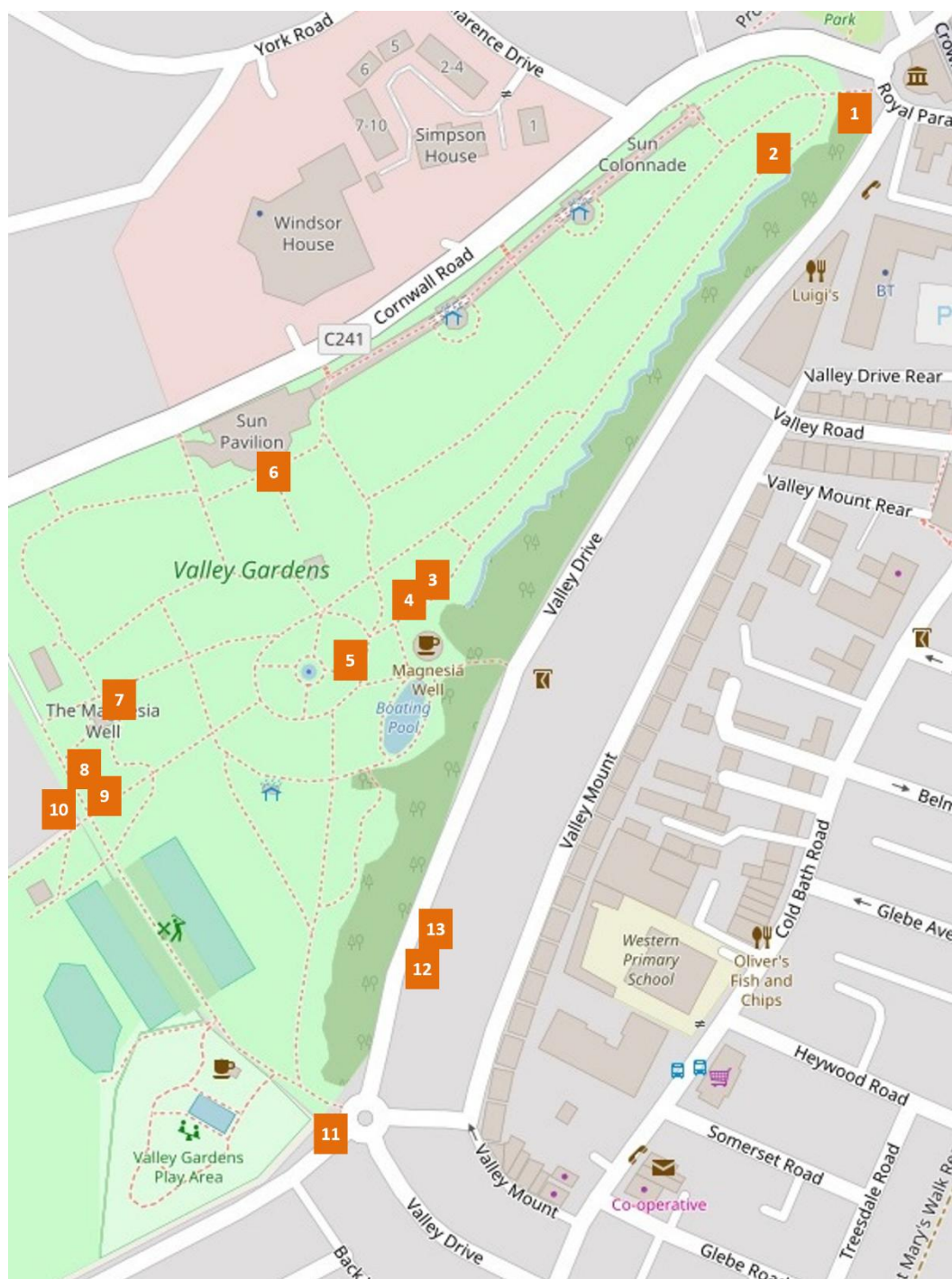


## Harrogate Brown Heritage Plaques – Valley Gardens Trail (Orange)



	Harrogate Brown Heritage Plaques Valley Gardens Trail (Orange)	Plaque commemorating	Plaque number
	This Trail starts by the Main town entrance to Valley Gardens (opposite Royal Pump Room Museum and is <b>0.8 mile (1.3 km) long</b> . The plaque number refers to the website numbering.		
01	Enter the Valley Gardens. Take the left hand path. The Plaque is mounted on the grass to the left hand side.	US Army General Hospital	XP08
02	Continue along the path for about 50 yards. The Plaque is on the grass on the right hand side.	The Elgar Walk	XP07
03	Continue along the path until almost reaching the Magnesia Well café. There you will see the double sided plaque set in the grass a few yards away.	Bogs Field (two sided)	Plq24

	The Plaque is on the right hand side of the path, by the Magnesia Well café.		
04	This Plaque is double sided, so view the other side.	Bogs Field (two sided)	Plq25
05	With the café on your left hand side, just past the café is a circular flower bed. Towards the left of this bed, there is a large tree. The Plaque is at the base of the tree.	Bogs Field (36 Springs)	XP01
06	Start to walk anti-clockwise round the flower bed, until you see the back of the bandstand. Follow the path that goes to the right of the bandstand and then up towards the Sun Collonade. As you reach the Sun Pavilion, turn to your left and follow the path below the Sun Pavilion. The Plaque is on the brick wall on your right.	The Sun Pavilion	Plq97
07	Follow the path from the left-hand side of the plaque. Around past the New Zealand Garden and then the toilet block on your right. Towards the end of this path is the Magnesia Well Pump Room Building. The Plaque is on the left hand, front of the Pump Room building.	Magnesia Well	Plq01
08	Continue to the end of the path, turn left and after a few yards you will see the Magnesia Well on your left. The Plaque is on the front of the stone Well head.	Magnesia Well	Plq33
09	A few yards further along the path on the left hand side is the Pure Chalybeate Well. The Plaque is on the front of the stone Well head.	Pure Chalybeate Well	Plq34
10	A few yards further along the path, the stone wall on your right hand side turns a corner. The Plaque is on the Wall corner.	Royal Bath Hospital	Plq78
11	Now continue along the path in the same direction, through the crazy golf and tennis courts to the Valley Drive entrance, where you leave Valley Gardens, through the King Edward VII Memorial Gate. Turn right. The Plaque is on the iron railings.	King Edward Memorial Gate	Plq79
12	Walk back past the Gate and go down Valley Drive, immediately crossing the road, after the roundabout. Walk down a few houses and look for no 97 Valley Drive <b>(This is a private residence – please respect their privacy)</b> . The Plaque is on the left hand side of the door.	Thomas Rutling	Plq73
13	Next door is no 93/95 Valley Drive <b>(This is a private residence – please respect their privacy)</b> . The Plaque is on the left hand side of the door.	JRR Tolkein	Plq39
	To return to the town centre continue down Valley Drive until you reach the bottom where it meets Royal Parade and you are back at the Royal Pump Room Museum.  Alternatively to return to the Magnesia Well Café, cross the road and continue down Valley Drive for a short distance until you see an		

	entrance to Valley Gardens in the hedge. Follow this path a short distance back to the café.
