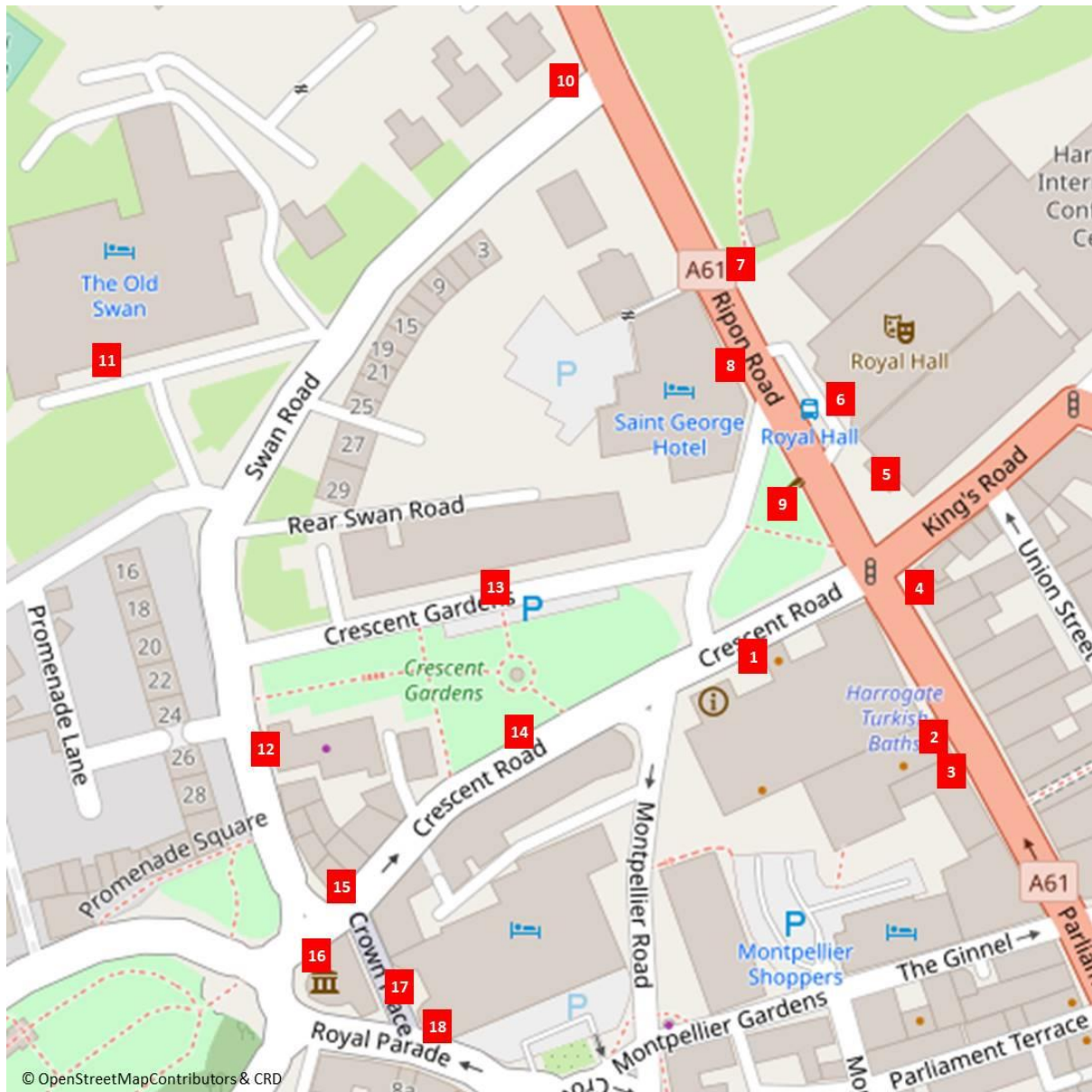


## Harrogate Town Centre Brown Heritage Plaques – Civic Trail (Red)

|   | This trail starts at the Tourist Information Centre and is <b>approximately 0.7 mile (1.1km) long</b> . The plaque number refers to the website numbering.  |                         |                  |
| 01  | On leaving the Tourist Information Centre, turn right along Crescent Road and almost immediately you come to the Royal Baths. The Plaque is on the main entrance, right hand side.                                    | Royal Baths             | Plq14            |
| 02  | Continue along to Parliament Street. Turn right and walk up Parliament Street to the Winter Gardens (Wetherspoons) and just go into the entrance. The Plaque is inside the entrance to Wetherspoons, right hand side. | Winter Garden           | Plq49            |
| 03  | The next plaque is also in the entrance on the left hand side.  | Water Gas Plant         | Plq54            |
| 04  | Now retrace your path back down to the bottom of Parliament Street, then cross Parliament Street. Turn right. The Plaque is on the left hand side, side door, Rhodes Woods, tailor's shop.                            | Louis Copé              | Plq90            |
| 05  | Now cross Kings Road. Here is the main entrance to The Harrogate  | Spa Rooms               | Plq65            |

|    | Convention Centre Exhibition Hall M. <b>If open</b> enter the Atrium.<br>The Plaque is in the Atrium. Left hand side, high on the wall.  |                        |       |
| 06 | Turn right out of the Atrium, next door is the Kursaal.<br>The Plaque is on the front stonework, towards the right hand side.  | The Kursaal            | Plq56 |
| 07 | Continue past the Kursaal and up Ripon Road.<br>The Plaque is on the boundary wall entrance, left hand post.   | Hotel Majestic         | Plq36 |
| 08 | Now carefully cross Ripon Road (using the pedestrian refuge in the middle) and turn left down Ripon Road.<br>The Plaque is on the main entrance to the Hotel.  | Hotel St. George       | Plq44 |
| 09 | Continue down Ripon Road, cross Montpellier Road and walk a little way down the Road.<br>The Plaque is in flower bed/ on wall, opposite George Hotel (& behind Bus Shelter)  | Cyclists' Touring Club | XP03  |
| 10 | Walk back up Ripon Road and on to the junction with Swan Road, cross the road.<br>The Plaque is on the north side of Swan Road, in the hedge.  | Swan Road              | Plq28 |
| 11 | Continue along Swan Road. The Swan Hotel is on the right. Please respect that the Hotel ground is private property.<br>The Plaque is on the wall by the side door, far left of main entrance.                                    | Swan Building          | Plq48 |
| 12 | Continue along Swan Road, past Crescent Gardens to the Mercer Art Gallery.<br>The Plaque is on the main entrance, left hand side.  | The Old Town Hall      | Plq12 |
| 13 | Walk back to Crescent Gardens and turn right. 100 yards down Crescent Gardens is the front entrance of the <i>former</i> Council Offices.<br>The Plaque by the front door, left hand side.                                       | Council Offices        | Plq05 |
| 14 | Turn to face the Crescent Gardens, walk to the display in the centre and continue on the path (towards Décor Lighting shop). On reaching Crescent Road turn right.<br>The Plaque is by path to the display in centre of gardens. | Crescent Gardens       | Plq06 |
| 15 | Continue along Crescent Road to the Hale's Bar Pub.<br>The Plaque is on the wall of the building to the far right of the building.   | Hales Bar              | Plq32 |
| 16 | Cross Crescent Road and turn right. The Royal Pump Room Museum is ahead on your left.<br>The Plaque is on the side, opposite Valley Gardens entrance (Cornwall Road).  | Royal Pump Room        | Plq15 |
| 17 | Walk back round the Museum to Crown Place.<br>The Plaque is halfway up Crown Place, on stone front opposite Royal Pump Room Museum.  | Crown Place            | Plq07 |
| 18 | Spitfire Aircraft<br>The Plaque is in the arched recess on the corner of the Hotel, up from Five Shillings Brasserie. (This plaque is coloured RAF Blue)   | Spitfire Aircraft      | Plq86 |
|    | You can return to the TIC by retracing your steps down Crown Place, turn right and walk along Crescent Road  |                        |       |
