

HARROGATE PLAQUES

There are 85 Brown Heritage Plaques in Harrogate (2019), having been installed over the last 45 years.

Harrogate Heritage Plaques are usually brown and mainly rectangular in shape.

The plaques tell a history of Harrogate, through its Spa heritage and the people and buildings associated with that history.

Some plaques mark out significant historical buildings in the town whilst others commemorate the men and women who were instrumental in the development of the town or ones whose businesses still play an active part in the town's fabric. Others commemorate famous people who have visited or had a connection with the town. Most plaques have a connection with the town's Spa heritage.

The Harrogate Civic Society has been, and still is, instrumental in getting plaques created and installed, along with serving as the guardian of the town's heritage.

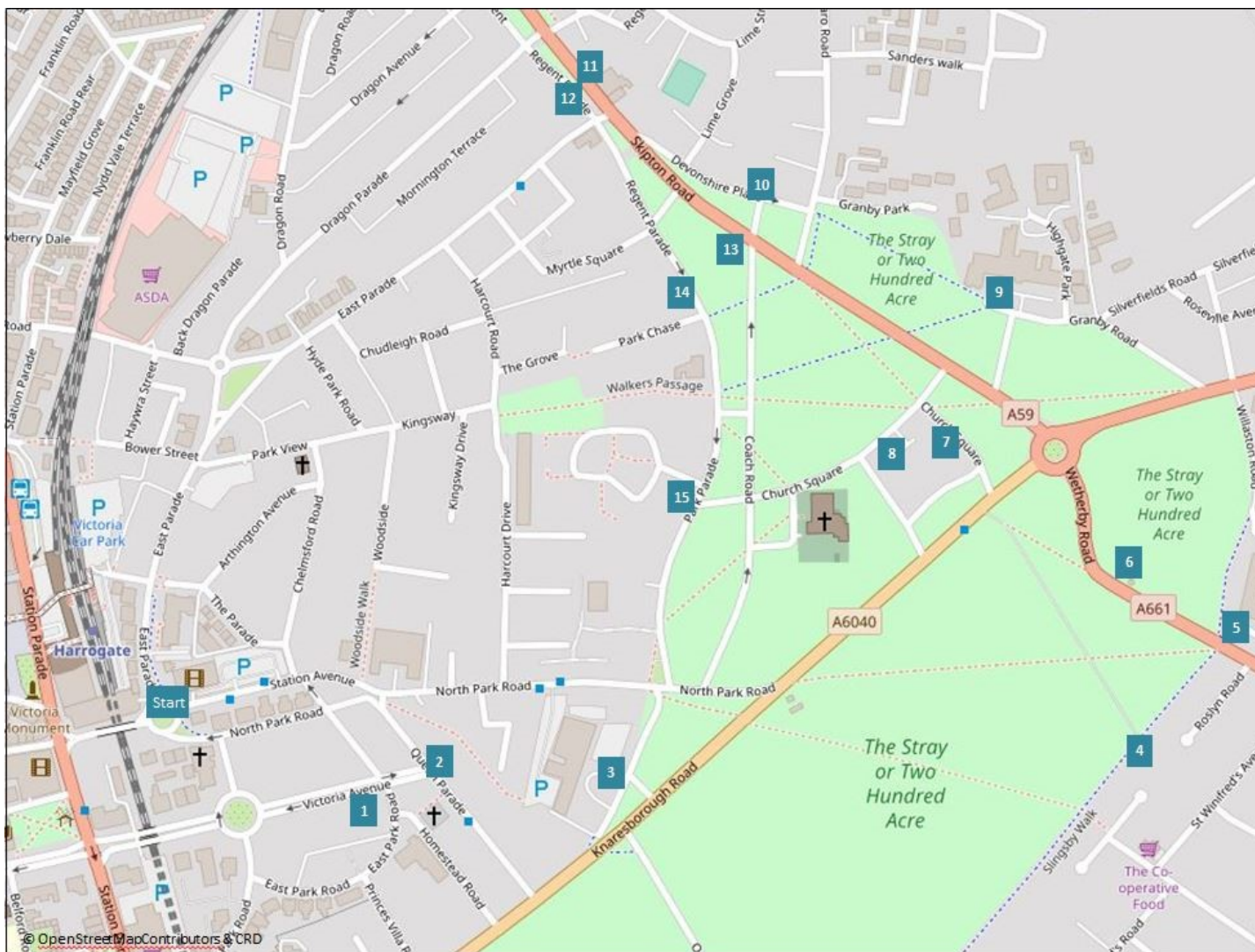

Please note that many of the plaques on this trail are on private residences. They are however next to the public footpath. Where the location opposite says 'private residence', the plaque is actually not closely approachable, but can be seen from the footpath.

6 High Harrogate Trail (Aqua)

Start—Odeon Cinema (Plq58)

01 The Club (Plq53)

(Next to the door—**private residence**)

01 The Harrogate Club (Plq89)

(On a plinth in the garden)

02 Richard Ellis (Plq60)

(On the stone post on main drive to the house)

03 Queen Hotel (the former) (Plq35)

(On the main entrance to Cedar Court Hotel drive)

04 Wedderburn House (Plq23)

(Right hand side gate post)

05 Grand Duchess George of Russia (Plq72)

(On the wall, next to the memorial cross)

06 St John's Well (Plq16)

(On the side of the building)

07 Mansfield House (Plq10)

(To the left of the door)

08 Church Square (Plq27)

(Just inside Church Mews on the right hand side)

09 Granby Hotel (Plq08)

(On the far left entrance post)

10 Gascoigne House (Plq75)

(To the right of the door—**private residence**)

11 Gable House (Plq85)

(On the iron railings, right hand side—**private residence**)

12 William Powell Frith (Plq55)

(On the side of the building, lhs—**private residence**)

13 Samson Fox Ox Roast (XP04)

(On the Stray—towards Coach Road, commemorative tree on the right)

14 Library House (Plq80)

(Far left side of the building)

15 20 Park Parade (Plq59)

(To the right of the door)
